Requested Change

Reclamation requests that the State Water Resources Control Board modify the permits listed in this petition to add Los Banos Creek Detention Dam and three downstream points on Los Banos Creek as points of rediversion of water previously stored by Reclamation, as shown on the attached map.

Reason for the Requested Change

The requested change is for the purpose of improving water supply reliability and drought supplies of up to 8,000 acre-feet per year for wildlife refuges, including Grassland Water District, and two other south-of-Delta CVP contractors located on Los Banos Creek, San Luis Water District and Central California Irrigation District (a member of the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors). CVP water will be rediverted to storage in Los Banos Creek Detention Reservoir for later delivery to these CVP contracting districts downstream at the points of diversion on Los Banos Creek.

To facilitate the requested change, a buried pipeline that varies in width from 36 to 54 inches with a capacity of 40 cubic feet per second will be installed to convey water into Los Banos Creek Detention Reservoir from a 40-cfs turnout owned by San Luis Water District. Reclamation and its participating CVP contractors successfull implemented a proof of concept for the requested change, installing and operating a temporary pipeline and receiving temporary change orders from the State Water Board. Appropriate CEQA documentation has been completed and all required permits have been obtained for the physical construction and operation of the permanent pipeline and appurtenant facilities.

The proposed change will not increase the quantity or alter the timing of Reclamation's diversions from the Delta, and will not reduce flows or impact water quality in Los Banos Creek, but will instead improve streamflow and reduce local flooding. All other provisions of the above permits protecting other legal water users, and environmental and other regulatory restrictions governing CVP operations, will remain in effect.
