

Partner Priority Interview

Questions:

1. Review priority habitats and focal species from Gen4 Strategic Plan. How do they align with native species and/or habitats that are conservation priorities for your program area or organization? Are there species/habitats we should be considering?
2. Review assessment of current condition/status of those priority habitats from Gen4 plan? Is there missing information? What new data or sources of information could be used to evaluate status?
3. Are there plans that support your priorities?
4. Review threats (and, if available, threat rankings) to priority habitats from Gen4 Strategic Plan. Have there been any changes (ie, can any threats be removed or need to be added)? Identified threats may include biological (e.g., invasive species) or human factors (e.g., conflicts with land use).
5. (For partners implementing habitat restoration) Review restoration/conservation strategies for priority habitats. Identify strategies that need to be removed or added.
6. Are there limiting factors (e.g., technical assistance, financial assistance, lack of partners on the landscape) that inhibit your program or organization's ability to implement priority conservation projects or actions?
7. What are your thoughts on the current priorities for the Partners and/or Coastal Program presented to you today? Is anything missing, from your perspective?
8. How can the Partners and Coastal programs best communicate with your office/program or organization about mutual conservation opportunities?
9. Do you see common priorities between our agencies/organizations/programs with respect to natural resource protection and restoration? How can we combine our efforts to be more effective and to be value added with each other?
10. Are there efforts your group is undertaking that would support Partners or Coastal Program efforts, e.g. habitat monitoring/modeling, population assessments and/or other biologist response data?
11. Do you have any suggestions for new partnership building opportunities for our programs?
